- A Touch Table will be available in the lobby before the show for audience members to explore some of the design elements of the production tactilely.

- In order to accommodate dietary restrictions, snacks from home are permitted; however, we encourage you to limit your eating to outside the theater or in lobby areas before the show and/or at intermission. Out of respect for our maintenance and staff members, please help us keep the theater clean. Our concession stand will be open before the show and during intermission.
- Flash Photography and Videography are NOT PERMITTED inside the theater. We want to enjoy the show while still respecting the theater's policies.

- A quiet area, staffed with volunteers, will be available in the theater lobby, and additional trained volunteers will be accessible throughout the performance to assist you. Our trained volunteers are ready and willing to help however they can!
- Slight adjustments have been made to the lighting and sound of the show. If an individual or family member experiences discomfort due to the lighting or sound, there are quiet areas they can visit in the theater. They can also utilize the ear defenders and sunglasses provided in the Sensory Kits. Our hope is to make this an enjoyable theater experience for all who attend the performance.
